It was Della and her lover and a dog named Jake

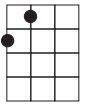

[C] Left Tucson in a [F] pickup truck.

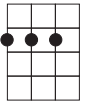

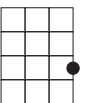

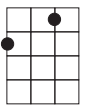
