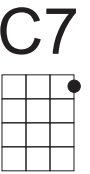
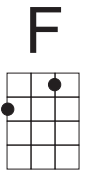
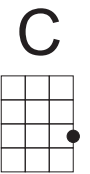


Good Old Colony Days
