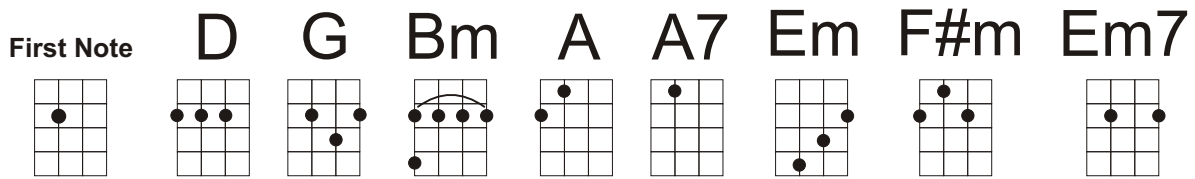


Leaving On A Jet Plane
