Seekin' my [G/F#] fame and [Em] fortune

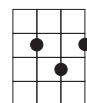
[C] Lookin' for a pot of [D7] gold

[G] Things got [G/F#] bad and [Em] things got worse

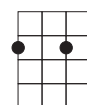
