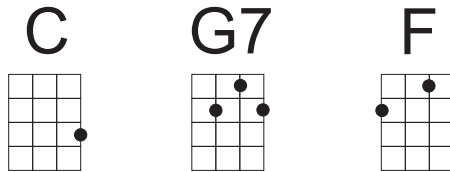


Long Haired Country Boy
