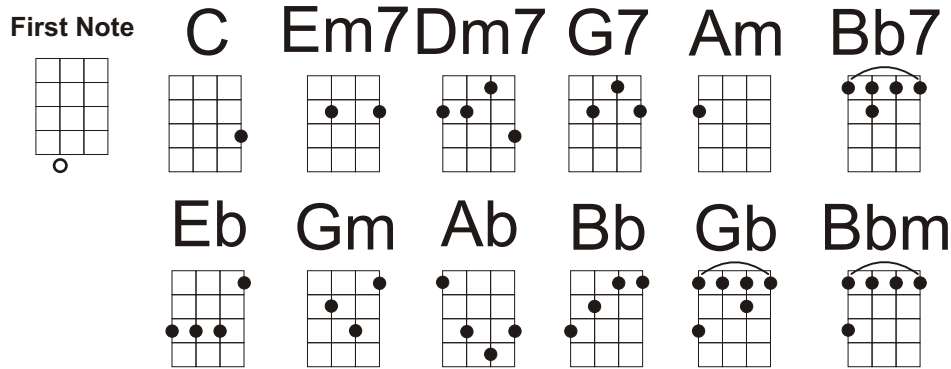


Mrs. Brown You've Got A Lovely Daughter
