Rol[G]ling, rolling, rolling on the river.

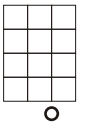
[G] Cleaned a lot of plates in Memphis,

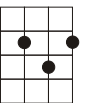
[G] If you come down to the river,

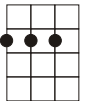
