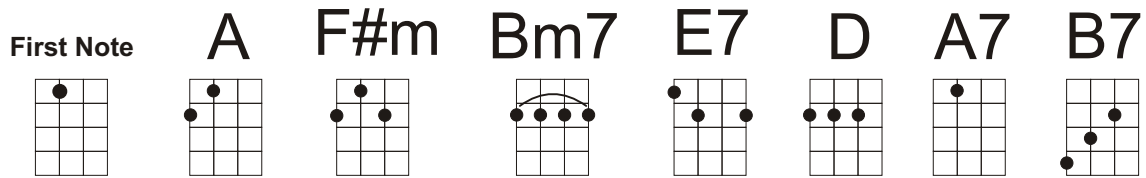


Return To Sender
