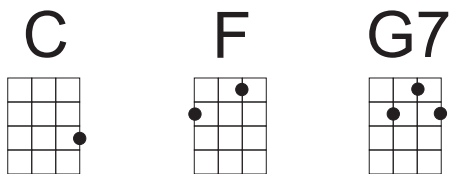


The Scotsman
