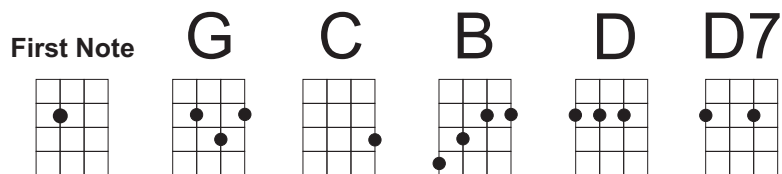


Worried Man Blues
